- Vehicle hire companies, and Electric/hybrid professional vehicle drivers

There are no formal entry requirements for this qualification and individuals are not expected to have any prior knowledge or experience, however an interest in the subject area is advisable.

Modules on the course:

The content of this qualification has been designed to give employees the knowledge required to work safely around electric/hybrid vehicles. It contains one mandatory unit covering:

- The types of electric/hybrid vehicles available
- Hazards associated with motor vehicle
- High energy electrical systems
- Working safely around electric/hybrid vehicles including charging

As a result...

Employees successfully completing this qualification will acquire significant core knowledge of working safely around, but not maintaining electric/hybrid vehicles.



This qualification will help support progression onto qualifications that further develop employees knowledge of either working safely in emergency or recovery situations or within a technical role carrying out routine servicing and maintenance activities on electric/hybrid vehicles.

Courses for progression include:
